

Curriculum Vitae di Rino Falcone

Rino (Rosario) Falcone è Direttore dell'Istituto di Scienze e Tecnologie della Cognizione (ISTC) del Consiglio Nazionale delle Ricerche (CNR).

E' laureato in fisica e le sue principali competenze ed esperienze sono nell'ambito *dell'Intelligenza Artificiale*; in particolare vanno *dall'elaborazione del linguaggio naturale*, al *riconoscimento di piani*, allo *sviluppo di modelli e sistemi nell'ambito dei Sistemi Multi-Agente* e della *Teoria degli Agenti Intelligenti*. Negli ultimi tempi ha approfondito gli studi sul *modello socio-cognitivo e computazionale della fiducia*.

È stato coinvolto in vari progetti nazionali ed internazionali: in particolare, è stato coordinatore europeo di "*MindRaces: from Reactive to Anticipatory Cognitive Embodied Systems*", un progetto sull'anticipazione cognitiva, organizzato nell'ambito del *sesto programma quadro della Comunità Europea*. Progetto finanziato con oltre due milioni di euro.

Ha pubblicato più di 150 articoli in conferenze e riviste. Ha organizzato diverse conferenze e workshop internazionali, in particolare negli ultimi 12 anni, sui temi della fiducia nella società ad agenti c/o la conferenza "Autonomous Agents and Multi-Agent Systems" (AAMAS).

È stato Editor di *Special Issues* di varie riviste internazionali (Applied Artificial Intelligence, Lecture Notes in Artificial Intelligence, Artificial Intelligence and Law, etc.). È stato presentatore di tutorials ed *invited speaker* sui temi di *Social Artificial Intelligence*. È coautore con Cristiano Castelfranchi del volume: "Trust Theory, A Socio-Cognitive and Computational Model" (Wiley, 2010).

E' inoltre da sempre interessato alle politiche della ricerca. Ha per questo organizzato e partecipato ad iniziative e proposte di vario genere. Ha fatto parte della Commissione, costituita dal Presidente del CNR, per la realizzazione del *primo Documento di Visione Strategica Decennale del CNR* ed è stato *Consigliere del Ministro dell'Università e Ricerca* Fabio Mussi per le questioni attinenti alla *ricerca scientifica*.
