

Fabrizio Davide: biographical statement



Fabrizio Davide (IEEE M'01) received a degree in electronic engineering with honours from the University of Bologna, Italy (1988) and a Ph.D. in electronic engineering from the University of L'Aquila, Italy (1994). Till 2010 he has been for 20 years an executive in the Telecom Italia Group, involved in cloud computing (SaaS and IaaS) for the public sector, IT governance and venture capital. He has coordinated a number of EU-funded RTD projects in the ICT Work Programme (the Integrated Project PASION, funded under FET Proactive in EC FP7 IP IST-027654 and CROSS, the most recent funded under the CIP Programme, EC CIP-324151) and is a member of European Union panels for the design of funding programmes and the evaluation of research proposals. He has been lecturing since 2004 at the University of Studies Rome Tor Vergata and lately at the University "Guglielmo Marconi".

He has published over 70 papers in refereed journals and conferences (orcid.org/0000-0003-1898-7336), as well as several book chapters. He is the inventor of an international patent on measurement of chaotic processes, and the editor-in-chief of the book series "Emerging Communications" (Amsterdam, IOS Press).

Among his current research interests there are digital social innovation and the future Internet. In the CROSS project he is harvesting the first scientific results regarding fact-based public decision making in the field of social services and welfare reform (see <http://www.crossprogramme.eu>).
