# Regulation for summoning the full and associate professors selected

GIVEN the law of 9 May 1989, n. 168 and in particular art. 6, clauses 9 and 10;

GIVEN the Ministerial Decree 17.4.2003;

GIVEN the University Statute approved with the decree of 15 April 2005, published in the Official Gazette of 12. 5. 2005;

GIVEN the law of 3.7. 1998, n. 210;

GIVEN the legislative decree 6.4.2006, n 164, relative to the reorganization of the recruitment regulations of university professors, and in particular article. 13;

GIVEN the decision adopted by Organizing Technical committee in its sitting of 23 November 2006;

GIVEN the note n. 4789 of 22.12.06 with which the Ministry of Universities and Research communicated as to having no observation to formulate in this matter;

The following regulation

### IS ISSUED

### Art 1

1. The present Regulation, adopted according to article 6, clauses 9 and 10 of the law of 9 May 1989, n. 168 and the provisions of article 13 of the legislative decree of 6 April 2006, n 164, controls the recruitment procedure at the International Telematic University of ordinary and associate professors found suitable according to the comparative assessment procedure announced by other University according to the law of 3 July 1998., n. 210;

#### Art 2

1. The Faculties, when they are certain of the adequate resources being made available, in respect to the limits and according to the modalities established by the academic Senate and by the administrative council, and in the area of planning mentioned in article 1, letter e) of the law decree 31 January 2005, n. 7, become law 31 March 2005, n. 4, can summon and nominate, with justifiable deliberation approved by the majority of those having the right to vote, candidates found suitable in the comparative assessment procedure relative to associate and

ordinary professors, as announced by other University centres, the same not having been nominated in the role in the above-mentioned centres or in other centres also.

## Art 3

1. The present regulation comes into effect from the day after its issue.
